

## campusWELTbewerb – Competition for global sustainability at universities in Baden-Württemberg

Dear international students and academics in Baden-Württemberg,

we invite you to participate in the second campusWELTbewerb, a competition to make the world a little - or a lot!? - better. If you are studying or working at a state or state-approved university in Baden-Württemberg we are looking forward to know about your project idea on global sustainability. A broad variety of topics and creative forms of implementation is welcome.

campusWELTbewerb wants to support initiatives that further sustainable development through awareness raising and practical actions within Baden-Württemberg.

Teams handing in a convincing project proposal on the subject of global sustainability can win a prize for the implementation of their project. Overall, we award 50,000 euros for about 8 to 14 projects. The quality of the project proposals which are submitted is key to decision-taking on prize-winners.

Project proposals can be related to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), the Global Action Programme on Education for Sustainable Development (GAP ESD), the German Sustainability Strategy or to the guidelines on development policy in Baden-Württemberg. Projects referring to these frameworks can take a critical viewpoint; nevertheless we are looking for constructive contributions towards local sustainability and global justice. Promising projects have a multiplication or imitation effect and rely on co-operation.

**Project proposals can be submitted until the 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2017 via the application form we provide.** On the website <http://campusweltbewerb.org> you will find detailed information on the university competition for global sustainability.

Anyway the idea is to work on a project together in teams so we kindly ask non-German speakers to cooperate with people who can do the translation.
